More Dark Clouds for Rainmaker

LAW: Now, creditors may get most of payout to Clippers dealmaker.

There have been so many comebacks in the 40-year career of mercurial attorney Pierce O'Donnell that spectacular reversals of fortune are almost expected.

Charged with campaign finance law violations - twice - he served time and his law license was suspended. But just in the last year, he got a new job with a national firm, brought in Shelly Sterling as a client and helped broker the sale of the Los Angeles Clippers. Then, only days later, he filed for personal bankruptcy. Now, due to get a \$2.3 million payday for his role

representing Sterling in the Clippers deal, O'Donnell

has seen all but \$200,000 claimed by the bankruptcy trustee managing his case. A hearing next week will deter-mine whether \$2.1 million of his Clippers bonus will be used to help pay his creditors, who are owed nearly \$7.5 million.

"I won the greatest cases of my career while I was under this dark cloud," O'Donnell said in an interview last week.

Indeed, O'Donnell's career has been marked by dark clouds that have cast a shadow over what otherwise would be a shining array of professional accomplishments. And the drama that has swirled around him

Discretion Paid In Bank Deal

Tinsel Town is full of rumors, but there wasn't a peep about the sale of Hollywood's bank until the deal was announced last week: City National Bank, the "bank to the stars" and the largest lender in Los Angeles, will be acquired by Toronto's Royal Bank of Canada for \$5.4 billion.

It's a deal that took everyone by surprise, including those who closely follow the bank. City National's longtime chief executive, Russell Goldsmith, though, said that level of discretion is a hallmark of his bank's culture - and one reason why it was such an appealing target.

City National wasn't on the market, hence the

LAX Hotels Aim To Land Events


